


Tu ai ocazia de a realiza mai multe stiluri de tricot cu prietenii tăi.




Produsul conține un cadru rotund pentru tricotaj de 18 sau de 6 croșete, lână de diferite culori, un cârmoc și o ac de plastic.



Choose the wool with which you want to start. Start from one of the ends of the frame. Make a snake of the wool alternating between the ends of the frame until you completely surround it. Leave one end of the thread about 20 cm and pass it through the middle of the frame.




Now, pass the wool to create a second row. This time, wrap the thread normally around the frame until it completely surrounds it. You will observe that the two rows of threads overlap in an alternating manner.




Use the hook included at the ends where the threads overlap. Lift the knot from the bottom over the top knot and pass it over the end of the frame.




Use the hook included at the ends where the threads overlap. Lift the knot from the bottom over the top knot and pass it over the end of the frame.



Repeat the procedure described at points A.3 and A.4 until you have finished with all the threads that overlap.




Thus, you create a base row that will look like the one illustrated in the diagram.



Guide the end of the thread and make it snake around each end of the frame. Lift the knot from the bottom over the top knot and pass it over the end of the frame. This is very important when you knit with different colors and will allow you to obtain a row of a single color before starting a new row with another color.



Cut the thread leaving three times the length of the hook, or more if you wish. Insert the thread into the hook according to the diagram.



Pass the hook with the thread through the ends of the frame according to the diagram until you finish a row. Then, make a double knot to fix it.



Lift the threads of each end of the knit, one by one.



After removing the knitted material from the frame, finish its end.



If you want to add another color, knit together the two threads of different colors.



With the help of the needle included, you can also add a face to the knitted rabbit.

Autre conseils:

The circular knitting frame can be reused, allowing you to have fun knitting different models. For this, you will need threads of different colors and you will apply the same circular knitting technique described above. If you wish, you can knit different colors together and continue. You can also knit threads of different colors to create a multicolored combination. If you want to knit differently, you can do it in a circular way, you can do it using only half of the frame and knitting in an alternating manner.
